

Minutes of the Town of Marshfield Annual Meeting
Town of Marshfield Hall – 7:30 p.m.
Tuesday, April 21, 2026


Chairman John Salzman called the annual meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were: Supervisors Mason Gukenberger & Randy Weigel, and Clerk Janet Meyer, residents, Bob Boehning, Joe Bores, Jerome Schiferl, and Pete Zygarlicke and non-resident Roger Meyer. Absent was Treasurer Scott Wunrow.

Motion Randy Weigel/2nd Joe Bores to approve minutes of the 2025 annual meeting. Motion carried 8-0.

- The 2025 Financial Report was presented and questions answered. **Motion Mason Gukenberger/2nd Randy Weigel to approve the 2025 financial report showing receipts of \$1,567,318.97, expenditures of \$1,221,845.82, a \$111,427.50 CD and an ending balance of \$456,900.65.** Motion carried 8-0.
- 1. Assessor – Open book will be held on April 28 from 5:30-7:30 pm and Board of Review will be held on May 7, 2026, from 7:30-9:30 p.m.
- 2. Roads –
 - All town roads are open to ATV/UTV traffic now.
 - Short Lane turn-around has been completed.
 - LRIP for McMillan applied for but we didn't get grant.
 - Culvert was installed on Stadt Rd.
 - After last week's storm a culvert on McMillan washed out and will be replaced with a larger 36'x50 culvert.
 - All town roads were inspected on Saturday. There are 5 culverts that will need replacing in the next year or two.
 - Complaint regarding railroad crossing on Stadt. Railroad reply was "Live with it"
- 3. Fire Department – Chief Roger Meyer had to leave on a fire call before he could make a report.
 - Reminder to call for burning permits at least 1 day before you intend to burn and that fire pits need to be inspected as well.
 - The fire engine is 22 years old now and they are in the process of replacing it.
- 4. Recycling –
 - Tire recycling is for residents only and will be held on April 26th from 8:00-12:00 at Pankratz Trucking 10719 Highway 10, East of Nasonville Dairy. The first 8 tires are free. After that there is a \$8 fee charged per tire – no rims are allowed on the tires. Tires larger than 10:00x22.5 & tractor tires will no longer be accepted. If you need a replacement red card, see the clerk.
- 5. Public Comments & Concerns-
 - No public comments.
 - Salzman noted that the City of Marshfield is looking to install 2 solar arrays on city well properties located in the Town of Marshfield on County Road T and Stadt North of the pit.
- 6. The 2027 Annual Meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 20, 2027, at 7:30 p.m. at the town hall.

Motion Randy Weigel/2nd Pete Zygarlicke to adjourn. Motion carried 8-0 and the meeting adjourned at 8:17 p.m.
