ADOPTING THE WOOD COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

FISCAL IMPACT: None

WHEREAS, the Town of Marshfield recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, under taking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Marshfield participated jointly in the planning process with Wood County and the other local units of government within the County to prepare an All Hazards Mitigation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Marshfield hereby adopts the Wood County All Hazards Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Wood County Emergency Management Department will submit, on behalf of the Township, the adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan to Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval. Minor changes made upon advise from Wisconsin Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency will not require re-adopting this resolution.
