ORDINANCE FOR WARD DIVISION AND DESIGNATING POLLING PLACE

WHEREAS, the Town of Marshfield, Wood County, Wisconsin is responsible for ward division and polling places in accordance with Section 5.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of July, 2011, the Town of Marshfield made and passed a motion to separate said Town into one (1) ward.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board does hereby create one (1) ward which consists of the boundaries of the entire township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for all voting purposes, the above ward will be combined, using one common polling place, which is named the Town of Marshfield Hall located at 11133 Main Street, Hewitt, WI 54441. The polling place, as required by law, is located in Ward One (1).
